
## Front Brake Caliper Disassembly/Assembly



## AWARNING

 A contaminated brake disc or pad reduces stopping power. Discard contaminated pads and clean a contaminated disc with a high quality brake degreasing agent.

## CAUTION

 Spilled brake fluid will damage painted, plastic or rubber parts. Cover these parts when servicing the brake system.

## Requisite Service

Brake pad removal/installation (page 12-2)
Front brake caliper removal/installation (page 12-8)
Brake fluid replacement/air bleeding (section 17 of the Common Service Manual)

Remarks Procedure Q'ty Assembly is in the reverse order of disassembly. Disassembly Order Note the spring direction as shown. (1) | Pad spring (2) Caliper bracket (3) Bracket pin bolt boot Install into the bracket groove securely. Caliper pin bolt boot 1 (4) Apply a locking agent to the threads before torquing. Apply Bracket pin bolt (5) Caliper pin bolt 1 silicone grease to the pin. (6) 2 Install them with the concaved side away from the pads. Caliper piston (7) 2 CAUTION Dust seal (8) Be careful not to damage the piston sliding surface Piston seal (9)

when removing seals.
