

Tighten the reservoir cap screws to the specified torque.

TORQUE: 1 N·m (0.15 kgf·m , 1.1 lbf·ft)

Check the front brake operation (page 3-26).



Pedal brake line

NOTE:

- Before performing this service, prepare the brake fluid 500 cm³ (16.9 US oz, 14.1 Imp oz) or more, because the brake line is long.
- Fluid filling and bleed air from the brake pedal line in the sequence as follow:
 1. Right front caliper center bleed valve
 2. Left front caliper center bleed valve
 3. PCV bleed valve
 4. Rear caliper center bleed valve
 5. Rear caliper outer bleed valve



Remove the seat cowl (page 2-2).

Remove the reservoir cap, set plate and diaphragm.

Fill the reservoir with DOT 4 brake fluid.



Pump the brake pedal while filling the brake fluid and feed fluid into the master cylinder.
